



## Federal Funding for the Drinking Water State Revolving Funds

The Infrastructure Investment and Jobs Act reauthorized the Drinking Water State Revolving Funds (SRFs) at \$3.25 billion for fiscal year 2025. Below are the estimated allotments for each state if the Drinking Water SRFs were fully funded this year. Allotments are based on available funding after allotments to Tribes and Territories and deductions by the U.S. Environmental Protection Agency.
